CALL TO ORDER: PUBLIC HEARING

The Public Hearing was held from 6:00 to 7:00 pm ET. The floor was opened to the public for discussion of Ordinance 2025-06, an ordinance Establishing Business and Occupational License Tax.

ADJOURN:

Since no one address the council about Ordinance 2025-06, Councilman Billy Snyder moved to adjourn the public hearing with no further business to come before it at 7:00 pm ET.

Councilman, Robert Young III seconded. All members present voting aye. Motion carried.

CALL TO ORDER: SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

Mayor, Charles Douglas Lucas called the Special Called Meeting to order at 7:01 pm ET. Prayer was led by Councilman, Robert Young III followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. Council Members present included: Robert Young III, Joey Medley, Jonathan Smith and Billy Snyder. Council Members absent included: Jonathan Mattingly and Rhea Ballman. Others present included: City Clerk, Sherrie Lawson, Ints Kampars with WXBC and City Attorney, Luke Babb.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. 2nd Reading Ordinance 2025-06: Establishing a Business and Occupational License Tax for the City of Irvington. Due to the length of the Ordinance, Mayor Lucas read Section 1, 2, and 3 ending on page 6. City Attorney, Luke Babb read Section 4 beginning on page 6 up to Section 5 ending on page 8. Mayor Lucas resumed reading on page 8 Section 5 and ending at Section 9 page 11. Attorney Babb begun reading on page 11 Section 10 and ended with Section 11. Mayor Lucas resumed reading on page 12 Section 12 and completed the reading of the Ordinance (see Ordinance 2025-06 for details). After some discussion, Councilman, Robert Young III moved to approve Ordinance 2025-06 as read. Councilman, Billy Snyder seconded. Mayor Lucas took a roll call vote with Councilmen, Robert Young III, Billy Snyder, Jonathan Smith and Joey Medley each voting aye. Councilman, Jonathan Mattingly and Councilwoman, Rhea Ballman were absent. Motion carried with all members present voting aye.
